

“Sprint with us” — Terms and Conditions

Promoter: Stile Education (ABN 98 159 359 681) of Level 10, 136 Exhibition Street, Melbourne, 3000 ("the Promoter").

By entering the Competition, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

1. Promotion Period

1.1. The Competition opens on 27th July and closes EOD on 31st August ("the Promotion Period"). Entries received outside the Promotion Period will not be accepted.

2. Eligibility

2.1. Entry is open to schools located in Australia that hold a current Stile subscription ("Eligible Schools").

2.2. For the purposes of this Competition, a "Science Department" means the teachers declared by an Eligible School at the time of registering for the Competition, via Typeform, as the members of that school's science department or science faculty ("the Declared Members"). The declaration must be made by the head of science, or the school's nominated Stile account administrator, before the Science Department commences the module. Only a school's science department is eligible; other departments or faculties cannot enter.

2.3. The Declared Members must be consistent with the science teachers who hold active accounts in Stile under the school's subscription. The Promoter may cross-check the declaration against the school's active Stile accounts, or ask for proof of the size of the department, and may reject or invalidate a registration where the Declared Members do not reasonably correspond to the school's active science teachers in Stile (for example, where science teachers active in Stile have been omitted from the declaration).

2.4. Declared Members who, as at the Snapshot Date, are on approved extended leave (including parental, long-service, sick or sabbatical leave) are not counted for the purposes of clause 3.1, provided the school notifies the Promoter at registration. Casual relief teachers, teachers who join the Science Department after the Snapshot Date, and teachers who leave the school's employment after the Snapshot Date are also not counted.

2.5. Directors, employees and contractors of the Promoter, and their immediate families, are not eligible to enter.

2.6. Entry is free. No purchase beyond an existing subscription is required, and entrants will not incur any cost to enter or to accept the prize.

3. How to Enter

3.1. To enter, every counted Declared Member of an Eligible School's Science Department (per clauses 2.2–2.4) must successfully complete the Explicit Instruction module in Stile during the Promotion Period. "Successfully complete" means to complete all lessons in the module and achieve a pass result in the associated assessment, as recorded in Stile.

3.2. A Science Department's entry is valid only if 100% of its counted Declared Members have successfully completed the module before the close of the Promotion Period. Partial completion does not constitute an entry.

3.3. Each Eligible School is entitled to a maximum of one (1) entry in the draw.

3.4. Stile's platform records are final in determining whether and when a module was completed. The Promoter may verify Science Department declarations against active Stile accounts and disqualify entries where membership has been misrepresented.

4. The Draw

4.1. The chosen school will be determined by random draw from all valid entries. The draw will be conducted at Level 10, 136 Exhibition Street, Melbourne at 11 am on 1 September 2026 (AEST) using a computerised random selection tool that gives each valid entry a random and equal chance of being drawn.

4.2. Entrants do not need to be present at the draw to win.

4.3. This is a game of chance. Skill plays no part in determining the winner.

5. Prize

5.1. There is one (1) prize, consisting of: (a) a credit equal to the winning school's Stile subscription fee for the 2027 school year, up to a maximum value of \$25,000 including GST; and (b) a catered lunch for the winning school's Science Department, up to a maximum value of \$2,500 including GST, arranged by the Promoter with the winning school.

5.2. The total maximum prize pool value is \$27,500 AUD including GST.

5.3. The prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash. The subscription credit will be applied to the winning school's account and has no cash value.

5.4. The prize will be awarded for the 2027 school year.

5.5. If any element of the prize becomes unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's control, the Promoter may substitute a prize of equal or greater value, subject to the winner's written agreement where required by law.

6. Winner Notification and Publication

6.1. The winner will be notified in writing (by email to the school's nominated account contact) within [two (2)] business days of the draw.

6.2. The winner's school name will be published on Stile Education's social media and via email on or around 1 September.

7. Unclaimed Prize and Redraw

7.1. If, after making reasonable efforts, the Promoter is unable to contact the winner or the winner does not claim the prize within three (3) months of the draw, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct a redraw on 1 December, 2026 under the same conditions as the original draw. Any redraw winner will be notified in the same manner as set out in clause 6.

8. Privacy

8.1. The Promoter collects entrants' personal information (including names, school details and contact details) to conduct the Competition, including verifying entries, drawing and notifying the winner, and awarding the prize.

9. General

9.1. The Promoter's decision in connection with all aspects of the Competition is final and no correspondence will be entered into, except as required by law.

9.2. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or that involves tampering with the entry process.

9.3. If the Competition cannot proceed as planned for reasons beyond the Promoter's reasonable control, the Promoter may, subject to any applicable law or regulatory direction, modify, suspend or cancel the Competition.

9.4. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies any consumer guarantees or rights under the Australian Consumer Law or any other applicable law that cannot lawfully be excluded. Subject to that, the Promoter is not liable for any loss or damage suffered in connection with the Competition or the prize, except for liability that cannot be excluded by law.

9.5. The Competition is a trade promotion (game of chance) conducted in compliance with applicable State and Territory laws, including the Gambling Regulation Act 2003 (Vic) and the Community Gaming Act 2018 (NSW).

9.6. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of Victoria, Australia.

Records relating to this Competition will be retained by the Promoter for a minimum of three (3) years after the Competition is finalised.
